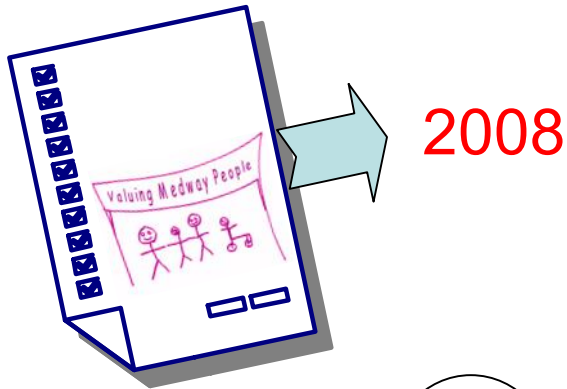

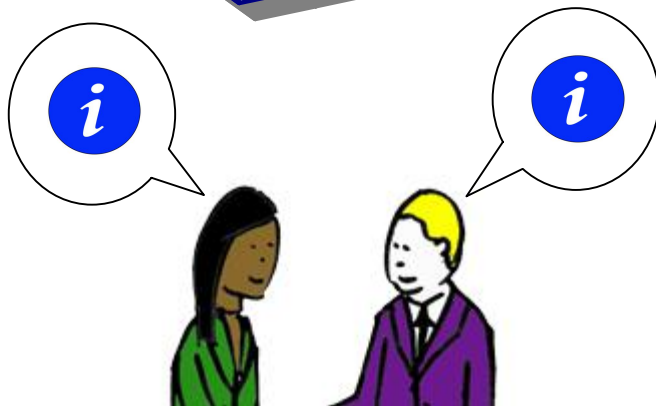

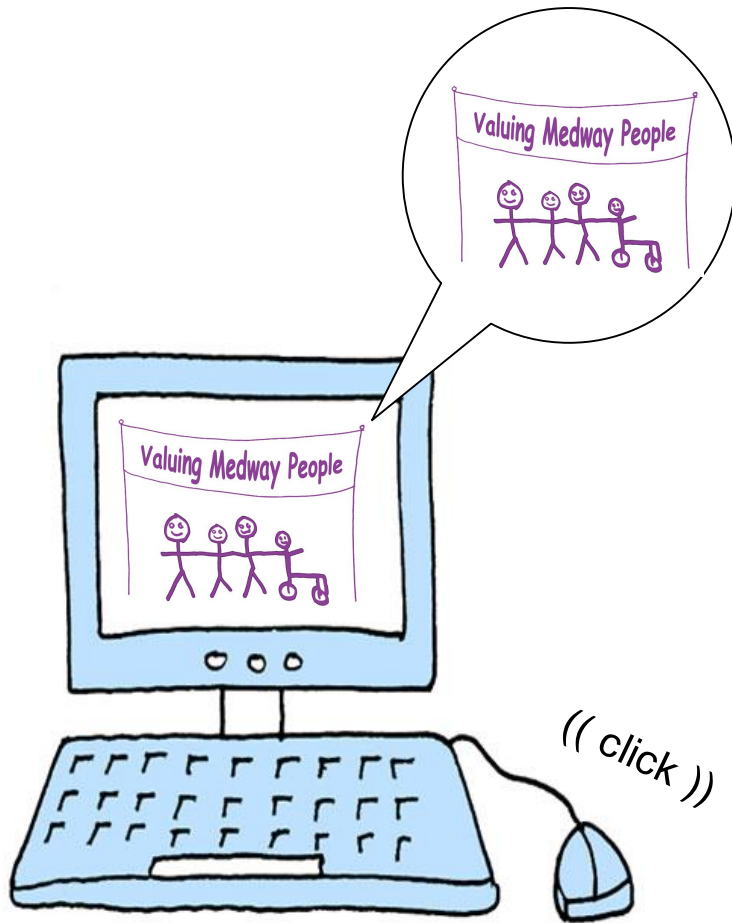
We will plan our 8 meetings for the year ahead.

We will do the most important things first.

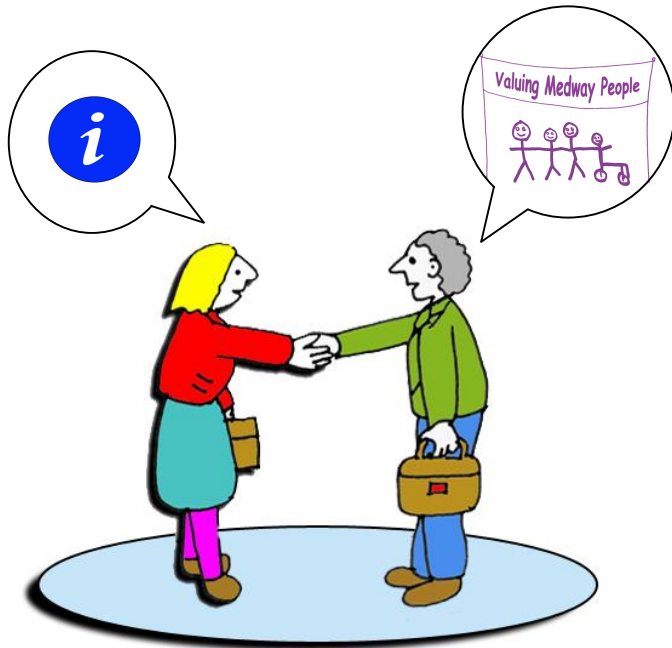

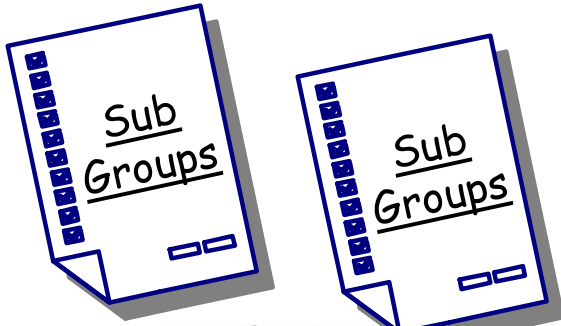

There will be 3 special events open to all in 2007 . They will be about:

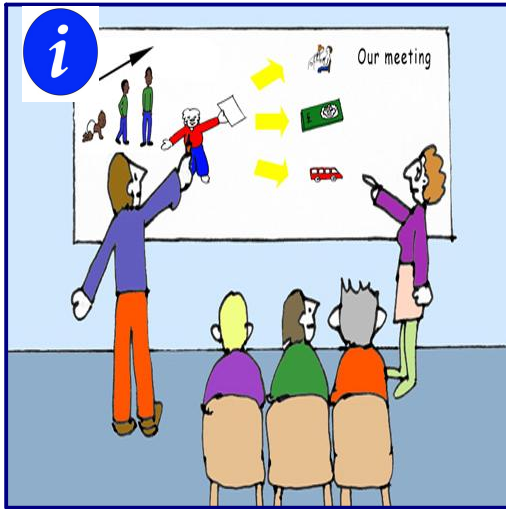
