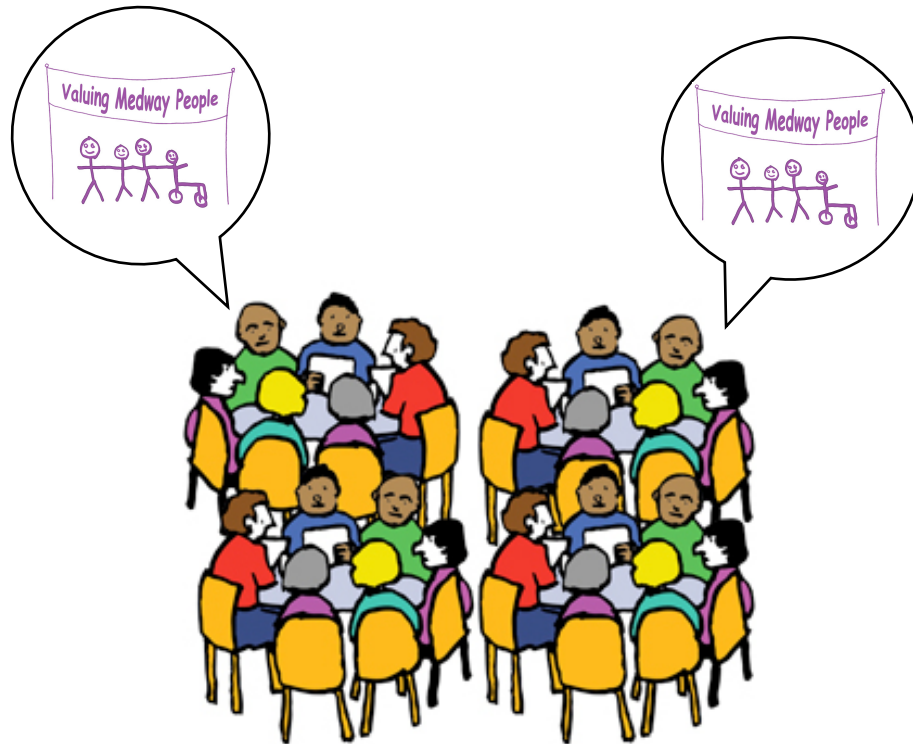


Forum for Adults with a Learning Disability

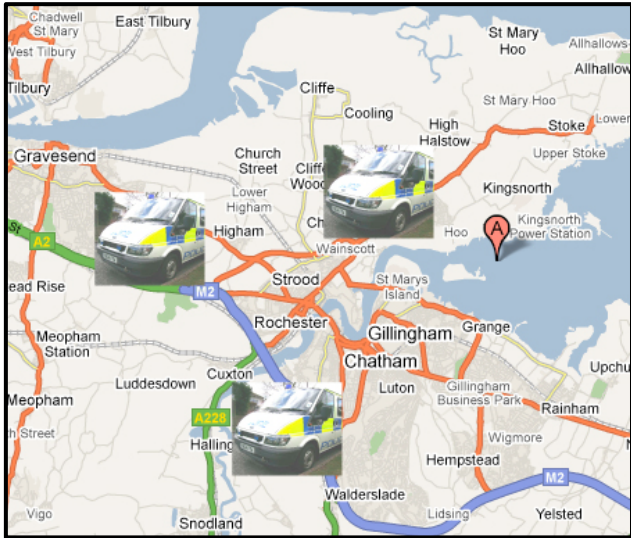
